
Books to read

Our topic is 'Special People'. We will be finding out about super heroes and their powers. We are also having an art week, when we will learn about Roy Lichtenstein and Pop Art. At the end of the half term we will be finding out about real life super heroes — people who help us. At home you could find out more about the jobs that people do, especially by talking to your child about the jobs that family members do. Spring 1 Special People

In phonics, we are using our knowledge of sounds to read and write ccvc and cvcc words. Don't forget to come to our Phonics Workshop to find out more about how you can support your child at home!









In maths we will be learning about zero, 6, 7 and 8, including finding 1 more and 1 less, doubling and odds and evens. At home you could count out sets of these amounts, and match the numeral to the sets. You could work out if 6, 7, and 8 are odd or even numbers, by matching up pairs and seeing if any are left over. If a number is an even number, you could talk about doubles.

We will also exploring and comparing by mass, capacity, length and height. There are lots of things you can do at home to support this — including comparing glasses of water and using language to describe them e.g. full, empty, part full.
