## Inside school this week....



Welcome back to the start of a new year and new term at Hook Infant School.

Koosa is running the new breakfast club as well as the after school club, Supersports is running the new Wednesday Football club starting next week and Hampshire Music service is teaching the new Year 2 Friday recorder club starting next week. As a school we have been promoting and embedding our school values encouraging respect, kindness, perseverance, teamwork and courage. Certificates are being presented to celebrate children positively portraying these values. Congratulations to our first recipients of our new awards.

A whole school lunch has again been organised for next Thursday 17th January 2018. The menu has been adapted slightly to encourage as many children as possible to participate and try something new.

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Mr West, Mrs Lochead, Ms Heinemann and Mrs Blewett will be running Wild Things again this Term for eight sessions. The cost is increasing slightly from £5 to £8 for the whole term to help us to update some of our equipment (such as sweep nets, survey sorting trays, identification guides, etc) but we hope that doesn't put off any would be young conservationists and we thank you for your continued support.

Each session will focus on a specific wildlife topic such as identifying a range of animals and plants, learning about habitats and habitat creation and a whole range of fun activities based around enjoying nature around us. Unlike other school clubs, it is important that the children have an interest in the subject as the emphasis will be strongly focussed on learning about wildlife and conservation rather than play based activities. Some of the activities for the Spring Term will include bird identification, animal sculptures, making hurdle fencing to protect sensitive areas and creating wildlife friendly habitats around the school grounds. All children are expected to bring wellies/rough shoes, warm outdoor clothes and a waterproof coat as we will be spending a lot of our time on practical activities and the children are likely to get muddy or messy.

If your child is in Year 1 or 2 and is interested in learning about local wildlife, habitats and conservation and would like to join us for the Spring Term (even if they came to the Autumn Term sessions) pop into the school office to register your child's interest before the end of the school day on Friday 19<sup>th</sup> January. As spaces are limited we will send a letter home on Monday 22<sup>nd</sup> January to notify you if your child has a space.
