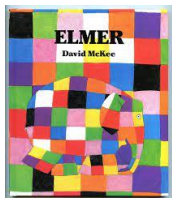
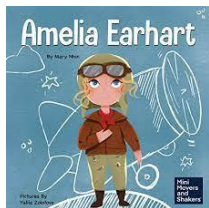
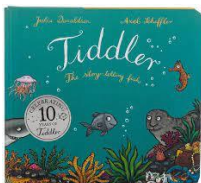
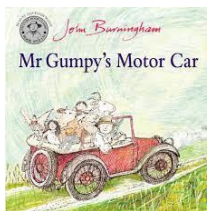
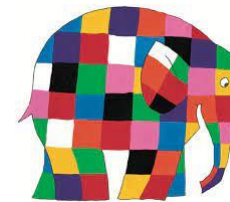


Books to read

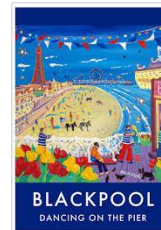
This half term we will be using lots of books to support our learning. If you don't have these books at home, you can use the QR codes below to watch them on YouTube.

In maths we will be learning about numbers to 20. Children will count to and from 20, looking at the numbers that come before or after a given number. They will also look for patterns in counting which will help them to count beyond 20. At home you could play games where children move along a number track. We will be looking at adding and taking away and exploring ways to do this as well as solving problems involving these operations. We will return to learning about shapes – making patterns and pictures and looking for 2D shapes within 3D shapes, as well as learning about shape rotation. At home you could look for shapes in the environment and talk about their properties.
