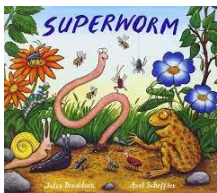
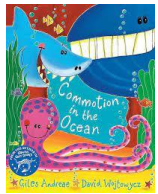
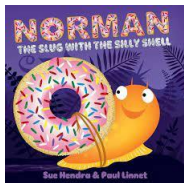
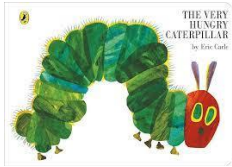


Books to read

Our topic is 'Minibeasts'. We will be learning about caterpillars and how they grow into butterflies. Each class will have some caterpillars that we will be watching very carefully so we can see how much they grow and change. When they have changed into butterflies we will let them fly off to a new home! We will also be learning about worms, slugs and snails. Towards the end of the year, we will start to learn about things that might be under the sea, and pirates, to help us with the learning the children will be starting in Year 1.



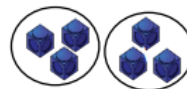
Summer 2 Minibeasts



In phonics, we will be learning about alternative ways to represent some of the phonemes we already know. We will be encouraging the children to use these in their writing as well as recognising them in their reading.



In maths we will be learning about grouping and sharing, which is the beginnings of multiplication and division. You could help your child with this by involving them when you are sharing things out at home. We will also be looking at patterns, pattern rules and pattern relationships. Being able to recognise and build patterns can help with understanding of number. We will be thinking about building models and how to give clear instructions to each other to build models, using accurate positional language. We will also be improving mapping skills.
