





## Books to read

Our topic is 'Let's Explore!'. We will be learning about how beans grow and will be trying to grow our own. These will come home for you to plant at home and see how tall they get! ## Let's Explore!



In phonics, we will be looking at common consonant clusters, which can come at the beginning or the end of a word. We will continue to focus on the rainbow words we have learnt and will be trying to use them in our writing as well.

In maths we will be continuing to think about length and height before we move on to numbers 9 and 10. We will find out about doubles of numbers, and number bonds of 9 and 10. We will use number lines to help us, and also a ten frame, which will help us to visualise the bonds and doubles while we are solving problems. We will use Numicon and ten frames to help us identify which numbers are odd and which are even. We will also be using number tracks to help us solve 1 more and 1 less problems. At home you could help your child by talking about doubles, odds and evens and 1 more/less when you are thinking about amounts up to 10.
