1. The School will:

I / We will:

- make sure that I strictly adhere to my child's arrival and collection times at school (8.30 arrival and 3.05 collection for Year R & 8:35 arrival and 3:10 collection for KS1)
- make sure my child attends school regularly and provide a note of explanation if absent;
- not take holidays or days out of school in term time and understand that if I do, I will be fined in accordance with Government rules;
- not take my child out of school during Phonics Screening week in Year 1;
- attend open evenings and discussions about my child's progress;
- let the school know about any concerns or problems that might affect my child as soon as I/we can, so that home and school can work together to find a solution;
- listen to my child read, at least three times a week to supplement the reading in school;
- practise weekly spellings in KS1;



- participate in any other home learning given, for example maths Rocket Challenges.

3. Together we will:

- promote positive behaviour, respect and discipline in our children in line with our behaviour policy;
- support any special educational needs or particular problems, to ensure that our children have a positive education experience tailored to their needs and interests;
- support our children's learning at home and at school to help them reach their full potential;
- ensure that we protect our children, staff and the school's reputation when using social networking sites.
