

Writing on a highlighted line allows children to gauge the correct relative size of each letter. Ascenders should be the same height above the highlighter, descenders the same length below the highlighter. The body of the letter should be formed to fill the highlighted line.

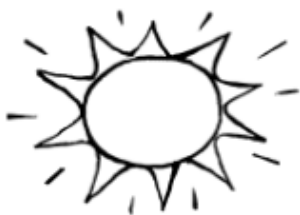

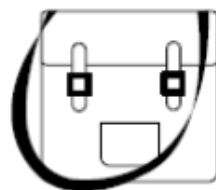

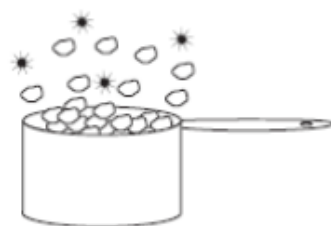
