Week 4: Percy the Park Keeper part 2

Before completing any of the activities below, please re-read or listen (<https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=aHPHmJXeWew>) to The Rescue Party by Nick Butterworth.

English - Percy and the animals all used great teamwork to rescue the rabbit from the well. You are going to change this part of the story! What animal could they rescue instead of rabbit? It could be the fox, hedgehog, the mice, badger. Then choose how they will be rescued: a bucket, ladder, branch. Write a short paragraph to describe how your animal will be rescued. You may wish to include adjectives and some speech!

Maths - Make a café menu with prices that **do not** go above 20p. Choose 2 to 3 items from your menu, add these prices up and see if you can make 20p! How many different ways can you find? If the total price does not make 20p how much change would you receive/

Science - After a huge storm Percy has decided to build a new hut. He went for a long walk around the park and decided to use sticks to build a new home. Has he chosen the best material? Investigate this problem by collecting sticks in your garden or local area and have a go at building him a home! Can you think of a better material he could use?

Art – Collect different shaped leaves and have a go at making a leaf pattern using paints! You could draw around the leaves and have a go at collecting different rubbings to compare markings. Have a go at drawing around leaves and writing the multiples of 5 inside each leaf!

Computing – Favourite fruit, Phonics: a_e, e_e, i_e phase 5, history changing homes, maths counting in 10s, geography maps.

DT – Percy and the animals would love to go on another picnic to enjoy the sunshine. Can you think of a healthy picnic for them to take outside? You could ask an adult to make and have your picnic at home or in your garden! You may wish to make a bird feeder and see what birds come to visit! Use the bird feeder guide to help.

Geography – Help! The animals have lost their map to the well! Draw a new map of their journey from the picnic to the well using the story to help.

History – Look carefully at the pictures of Hook. Can you find any similarities and differences between the pictures from long ago to today?

Music – The animals would like your help to learn a new song to sing at their picnic! You could make your own song or perform '5 little ducks' to a family member! If you do not know this song have a listen on Youtube first: <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=pZw9veQ76fo>

P.E - balancing activities. Can you create a circuit in the garden/local park/space around your house to test your balance? You could try walking across stepping stones, along a log/plank of wood, balance on one leg for 20 seconds, hop on one leg up and down your garden/from side to side of a path.
