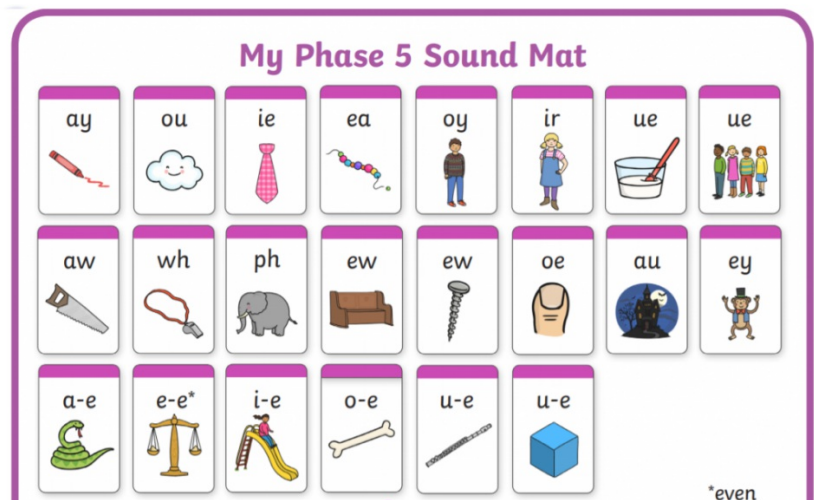


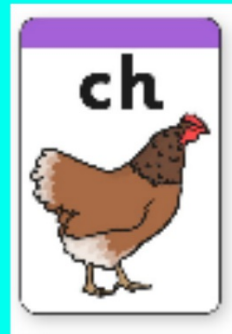

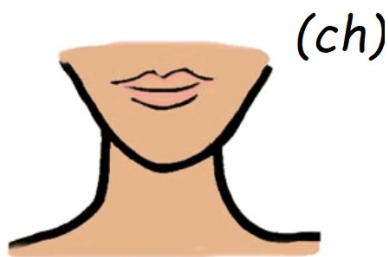


*What is this phase 3 digraph?*

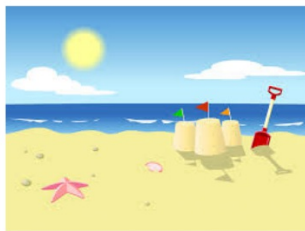

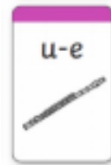
