Week 6: Smartest Giant in Town Part Two!

English – Character description. Draw or print a picture of George and label the different features you see using adjectives. Write some sentences or a short paragraph about his appearance, personality and what he is like. You may wish to use the adjectives you made last week to help you.

Maths - Create a price list of the giant's clothes with prices but do not go over 50p! Buy 3 pieces of clothing and add these together to find the total cost. Do you have any change? Can you work out how much you would receive? What coins would you pay with? Have a go at ordering your family from smallest to biggest! Measure each other using m and cm. You could draw around each other in chalk on the ground to compare sizes.

Science – Use the challenge from last week: Have a conversation with an adult which would be the best material to:

- Build a new house for the mice in the story.
- A new gown for George
- A sleeping bag for the fox. This one needs to be waterproof in case it rains!

Choose one of these to investigate! You may choose to build a new house for the mice by testing a house made out of sticks, stones, marbles, plastic bricks/bottles. Which material was the best? Why?

Art – Draw your favourite animal from the story and decorate using pencils, felt tips, paint, natural resources. You may wish to include bark rubbings too or make a collage using your favourite colours!

Computing – Purple mash activities: writing – describe a setting, maths – telling the time quiz, phonics – ir and ue, geography – compass directions, science – animals and their homes pairs.

DT – The goat needs your help! Can you design and build a new boat for him to sail across the sea? You could go to your local park or look around an outside space near you to collect materials. Follow the link below if you would like to make a paper boat!
